

Day 1 Teaching Session Word Cards Backside (teacher viewed with script read to student)

- 1) "What is this word?" (If correct say, "Yes, review" if missed say, "No, review")
- 2) "Re means again"
- 3) "Review means to view again"
- 4) "The teacher will review the story before the test"
- 5) "Now you read the word." (Nod acceptance or say No, review if they missed word)
- 6) "What is this word?" (Nod acceptance or say No, review if they missed word)
- 7) "What does it mean?" (Accept any correct use or definition. Repeat sentence if child is stymied.)
